



## Sample Results Summary

This will download or display a data file with one row per sample, showing the tests for that sample in separate columns.

If you download in spreadsheet format, the data is put in an Excel compatible datafile. The downloaded file is a simple text file with tab separated values. Excel will load this automatically, but you will need to adjust the columns, and change the column format. Excel tries to figure out how to format a column, and is very often wrong. For example, it may try to convert numbers into dates.

If you want to save it as a text file, simply change the extension on the downloaded file name to ".txt" instead of ".xls" You can then import it to Excel, and assign formats to each column to prevent Excel from changing your data.
